Why read and study the Book of Exodus?

Author: Moses

Date of Exodus: 1446 BC

There is a “typological parallel between the historical Exodus and the Messianic Salvation.”

The LORD (YHWH) revealed His Name to Moses. He raised Moses to deliver the Israelites from slavery to Egypt. He led Israel to the promised land.

Likewise, the Heavenly Father sent Jesus to deliver sinners from bondage to sin and Satan.

The Saviour Jesus leads us in the new and greater Exodus to the heavenly kingdom.

The Exodus deliverance pattern continues in the New Testament:

1) The LORD (YHWH) is the Deliverer.

2) The deliverance is from bondage as slaves to the freedom as God's chosen spiritual children.

3) Moses led Israel out of idolatrous Egypt to worship the LORD. Jesus draws idolatrous humanity to worship God in Spirit and in truth.

4) Worship of God is relational and from the heart. Warnings of disobedience by the Exodus generation are warnings for Christians today (1 Cor 10:1-13).
